<p><u>ITEM 2: Discussion of changes to Chapter 26 – Environment, Article III Noise, Chapter 38 – Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Chapter 54 – Traffic and Vehicles.</u></p> <p>Mr. Lamb asked to wait a few minutes for Officer Tim Deluca to show up, as he was expected to be here. After a few minutes Mr. Lamb proceeded to discuss the packets to make sure everyone had the noise consultant’s version and the updated ordinance. The committee had all their information. Packets were available for the other attendees.</p> <p>Vice Chair Mailhot stated she was really going to rely on the input of Mr. Lamb and the police department for the noise ordinance.</p> <p>Mr. Lamb stated that Officer Deluca is the expert on this and that he did not have much input.</p> <p>Vice Chair Mailhot questioned the committee as to if this should be tabled. The committee all agreed.</p> <p>Mr. Bryant wondered if there is a map to reference the noise consultants zones regarding different levels. If so, the committee should have this.</p> <p>Mr. Lamb explained the mapping and zones and have difficult the zone approach is.</p> <p>Ms. Brown did not think the version was the most current from the sound consultants. She felt the 100 foot measurement was the most important aspect.</p> <p>Ms. Payette asked if the traffic and vehicles section would be addressed tonight, as the memo in the packet stated the police department was not ready tonight for this.</p> <p>Mr. Lamb confirmed that. He asked what part they were concerned about.</p> <p>Mr. Payette stated that they have a business on East Grand and just wanted to stay up on any changes that may be proposed to parking and traffic on East Grand.</p> <p>Vice Chair Mailhot moved on to Chapter 38 and the committee reviewed suggested changes from the last meeting which included adding “rifle” to section 38-29 subsection a,4 and to delete the second sentence of section 38-242, subsection c. The newspaper vending machine ordinance needs to be researched by Mr. Nugent.</p> <p>Mr. Lamb then asked how the committee felt about boarding up.</p> <p>Vice Chair Mailhot stated the committee had talked about this during the last meeting. She felt this was fine as it was. She asked if the committee agreed, and they did. There will be no changes to this section. Ms. Mailhot then stated the committee would table Chapter 38 and Chapter 26 for the next meeting.</p>	<u>ITEM 2: Discussion of changes to Chapter 26 – Environment, Article III Noise, Chapter 38 – Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Chapter 54 – Traffic and Vehicles.</u>
