## **SIDEWALK SERVICES FOR THE TOWN OF OLD ORCHARD BEACH**

### **A. Introduction**

The Town of Old Orchard Beach is requesting bids from vendors to provide masonry/brick & concrete sidewalk construction/reconstruction for municipal facilities for a one-year period, expiring December 31, 2012, with an option by the Town to extend one additional year, until December 31, 2013.

### **B. Scope of Work**

The proposal shall be based on time and materials. Scope of work will include, but not limited to; coordination with Department of Public Works. When emergencies are reported a response is required in 24 hours or less.

### **C. Requirements**

Repairs as required will include; for concrete sidewalks: form, fine grade, pour and finish, and for brick sidewalks: remove, fine grade and reset. Town of Old Orchard Beach prefers proposals to be concise and easy to understand. Do not include unnecessary or extraneous information. Please format the proposal with the following sections. Include all information requested.

### **Section I – Corporate Profile**

This section should include a brief overview and history of your company. Include information about knowledge and experience in the sidewalk construction industry. Provide the number of similar accounts that your company has, with specific information. Provide proof of general liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00.

Also, include a list of at least three customer references with similar needs. Include company name, address, phone number, and point of contact.

### **Section II – Pricing**

Pricing must be submitted in a sealed envelope. An estimate will need to be approved prior to any work, by the Director of Public Works. The estimate must include time and expected materials to be used. The Town will not pay for travel time, mileage, or a first-hour service call fee. Prior to any work, a purchase order will need to be approved by the Town Manager.

**Pricing to include:**

Concrete sidewalk

A. Form, fine grade, steel, pour, finish \_\_\_\_\_ per sq. yd.

B. Steel, pour, finish \_\_\_\_\_ per sq. yd.

Brick sidewalk

A. Remove, fine grade, reset \_\_\_\_\_ per sq. yd.
