Attention Neighborhood Watch and Citizens:

- 1- Over the last few days we have taken reports of residential Burglaries and attempts. Specifically, two have taken place in the area of the Salvation Army Campground also known as the Old Campground Neighborhood Watch area. Please report any suspicious activity, more specifically a male that may be in the area acting suspicious. It is believed a male is knocking on doors during the day time hours looking for unoccupied homes. In one case, we believe the suspect actually asked for a plastic bag from a citizens to carry stolen items. The male is described as early 20's, average build with dark hair. If you notice anything suspicious, call 911 immediately.
- 2- It is that time of year many of our seasonal homes are being vacated and our neighborhoods less populated in some areas. It's also the same time last year some of our citizens homes became victim to copper thefts. Chief Kelley wants to be more proactive in dealing with this issue this year in hopes to eliminate it from happening again. Please be on the lookout for suspicious activity often where a vehicle is involved. In fact, it may even seem like a routine service to the home i.e. a plumber performing seasonal service. Be suspicious of this activity and call 911.
