Dear Spay Maine Supporters,

We are emailing you to ask you to spread the work on this event to any low-income Mainer's you may know who live near one of these three shelters and who need help spaying/neutering their cat.

The Animal Refuge League in Westbrook, Coastal Humane Society in Brunswick, and the Animal Welfare Society in West Kennebunk have teamed with local veterinarians, to reach a goal of spaying and neutering 1,000 cats belonging to low-income Mainers, during the month of February. The work of this collaboration is in commemoration of the HSUS' 16th annual International Spay Day, which is on February 23. The event will take place with low-cost, high quality spaying and neutering surgeries conducted at area veterinarians throughout the month of February.
