PARKING LOCATIONS FOR VEHICLES TO PARK DURING A PARKING BAN

THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS ARE DESIGNATED AS PARKING AREAS THAT CITIZENS CAN PARK WHEN THE TOWN HAS DECLARED A PARKING BAN.

- 1. MILLIKEN STREET PARKING LOT**
- 2. MEMORIAL PARK PARKING LOT – FIRST ST.**
- 3. SQUARE IN OCEAN PARK**
- 4. JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL PARKING LOT (ADJACENT TO E.EMERSON CUMMINGS BLVD)**

DEPENDING ON THE STORM ALL FOUR LOCATIONS MAY NOT BE PLOWED DURING EACH STORM. PUBLIC WORKS WILL DO THE BEST IN KEEPING ALL LOTS OPEN AND ACCESS TO THEM.

AS SOON AS THE PARKING BAN IS OVER YOU ARE ASKED TO RETRIEVE YOUR VEHICLE FROM THE LOT. THIS WILL ENABLE PUBLIC WORKS TO PROPERLY PLOW THE LOT IF NEEDED.

*******SCHOOL PARKING*******

IF YOU CHOOSE TO PARK AT THE SCHOOL LOT YOU ARE ASKED TO REMOVE YOUR VEHICLE AS SOON AS THE PARKING BAN IS OVER IN ORDER FOR THE MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL TO PROPERLY PLOW THE LOT FOR SCHOOL EMPLOYEES.

IF SCHOOL IS IN SESSION YOU MUST REMOVE YOUR VEHICLE BY 6AM. IF A PARKING BAN IS STILL IN EFFECT YOU WILL NEED TO RE-LOCATE TO ANOTHER LOT. IF YOUR VEHICLE IS NOT REMOVED IT MAY BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.
