Update for March 18th, 2021

Town Information:

- The Vaccine Information Line is available for residents to call Monday through Friday from 8–5. The number is 866-962-6062. This is NOT to schedule vaccine appointments but to provide answers to questions you may have about the vaccine. Some examples of questions commonly asked are: What group is able to get vaccines now? If I have allergies should I still get a vaccine?
- Property Taxes are due March 24th. Town Hall tax department will be open extended hours Saturday March 20th from 9-2 and Wednesday March 24th from 3-6. Extended hours are for payment of property taxes only.
- The new message board is up and running at the Town Hall! This is one more way for OOB residents to get information about what is happening here in town. Check it out next time you are downtown.
- Town meeting schedules are posted on the town website www.oobmaine.com under the calendar section on the bottom left hand side. Town Council meetings are the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays of the month and agendas are posted on the webpage. - The Chamber of Commerce along with other exchange partners will host an informational meeting about the Exchange Visitor (J1) Program. While the percentage of students who will be coming to OOB this summer is small, and to date we don't have an exact number, the session will cover information about housing and labor laws for those employing or renting to these students.
