- Memorial Day is Monday, May 31st and the town will be resuming their annual parade this year. Parade begins at 1PM on Old Orchard Street. Also beginning the 31st will be the nightly flag lowering ceremony at Memorial Park. The ceremony occurs every evening at 6PM throughout the summer.
