1. Acceptance of minutes from 1/21/16: Debbie accepted, Peg seconded.
2. We received a donation of \$1000, with the request that it be used for vet bills for seniors. The Committee agreed.

11. The storage unit is half empty. It has to be emptied by March 10 or we will have to pay for another month. A high school volunteer has been helping Bev to empty it.
12. Joe will check Cabela's and Kittery Trading Post to find out if they have the coyote urine and how much it costs, to deter the fisher.
13. Starting in May we will have to meet in the conference room. Michelle will call to get it set up. Officer Will will have to attend the meetings.
14. We are in need of more board members. Michelle will bring applications to the next meeting.
