1. Acceptance on minutes from 12/17/2015: Michelle accepted, Denise seconded.
2. Michelle was voted in as Chair and Denise as Vice Chair.
3. We have received a large donation of dog and cat food. We can use the facility on Portland Avenue to store it, as well as other things. Bev has the key.
4. We have two students interested in helping us for their community service.
5. Ten feral shelters have gone out so far. Joe and Karen are helping Michelle and Daniel to build them.
6. The fisher is still around. Peg has called Bruce Martin. He wants to be paid and he would set up another neighborhood meeting. He would put traps out again. We will put an announcement on Face Book. Joe said that coyote urine is a repellent for fishers, and they sell it at Cabela's. He said he will look into it if needed. We will revisit the issue in the Spring.
7. John Byrd has adopted Hobbs. One cat found on Old Salt Road has also been adopted. The other cat from there was someone's pet and had been lost.
8. Coupon books and money are due at the end of the month. We will have a Bake Sale at Pet Life in Saco from 10-3. Peg, Debbie, Joe, Karen, and Tom have volunteered for it. The Pet Life in Scarborough also wants us to do a Bake Sale at a

future date.

9. A rummage sale is planned for the first week in April at Saco Grange. We will be selling clothes, pocket books, shoes, crafts. Also a 50/50 raffle. We will find out more about it next month.

10. Beverly has received an anonymous donation of a vehicle. The money that was donated for the vehicle is to be used for insurance and registration. The next payment for insurance is due in April for \$388.

11. The Committee has decided to give Beverly \$40 a month for gas money and mileage. She will let us know when she needs more. We are asking her to keep and submit receipts.
