- 3. Sumter Landing and the Solar Farm

 - Can the DPW help with the clean up?

- 4. Guild Park Clean Up Grant Request for \$5300 from Project Canopy. If they don't get the grant, the Con Com will consider helping them take care of Guild Park.
- 5. Good and Welfare Kimbark is writing the RFP for phragmites, and will request to include <u>black swallowwort</u>. Mother plant on New Salt Rd is blooming, across from the tide gate. The owner endorsed removal.
