

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
MUNICIPAL OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF
OLD ORCHARD BEACH

The Municipal Officers of the Town of Old Orchard Beach, Maine hereby give Public Notice that there will be a Public Hearing held at the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on October 19th, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. to consider the following questions for the June 14, 2022 ballot. The underscored words are being added:

Text of proposed Town of Old Orchard Beach Charter amendments to be placed on the June 14, 2022 election:

1. Shall the municipality approve the charter amendment reprinted below, with an effective date of June 21, 2022?

Sec. 401. Qualifications.

Councilors shall be registered voters of the Town and shall have their principal place of residence in the Town during their terms of office. No member of the Town Council shall hold any other compensated Town office, be employed in any Town department, nor serve in any position appointed by the Town Council under Section 409.3 of this Charter, during the term for which that member was elected to the Town Council with the exception of Inter-Governmental Groups and Charter Commissions in accordance with the State Statutes and with the exception of part-time or seasonal employment that is not in violation of State or Town conflict of interest laws or policies. If a Town Councilor shall cease to possess any of these qualifications or shall be convicted of a crime which is punishable by imprisonment for more than six months, the seat of that Town Councilor shall immediately become vacant.

NOTE: The question shall be submitted to the voters at the next regular municipal election held not less than thirty-five (35) days after the order, resolve or ordinance is passed; or the Town Council may order that the question be submitted to the voters at a special election to be held not less than thirty (30) days from the date of the order, resolve or ordinance.
