## What to Do After a Disaster

Whether returning home or venturing outside for the first time, beware of new dangers that may have arisen because of the disaster. You may experience washed-out roads, downed power lines or poles, contaminated drinking water or other hazards. Report problems promptly to local officials so that corrective measures can be taken.

## **INSPECT YOUR HOME FOR DAMAGE**

- Look for structural damage, loose or damaged wires and gas leaks before reentering your residence. If you doubt the structures safety, contact a professional before entering.
- Do not enter a fire-damaged house until authorities have inspected it.
- Check the refrigerator and discard spoiled food.
- Contact your insurance agent.
- Contact public safety departments if needs arise.
