Community Events and Activities:

- The VFW will be having a voluntary traffic stop on Saturday May 28th from 8-4. to collect Members will be collecting Donations for Poppies, in honor of Memorial Day, at the intersection of East and West Grand and Old Orchard Street.
- Sunday from 5-9PM Veterans Memorial Park will host a Luminary Night. 200 glowing luminaries will line the walkways and a bagpiper will play in tribute to our Veterans. Those who wish to purchase a luminary may do so that evening.
- The Memorial Day Parade will be held on Monday, May 30th, 2022. The line-up starts at noon by the Police Department. Stepoff is at 1 p.m. The parade route goes down Saco Avenue, turns right on Old Orchard Street and right onto First Street and into Memorial Park, where a ceremony will be held.
- On Saturday June 4th OOB365 brings the Scottish Festival to Veterans Memorial Park. The Festival runs all day and features Scottish Highland games, music, dancing and food!
