Town Government:

- Town Council will meet Wednesday June 30th at 6:30PM in Council Chambers.
- Town Hall will be closed on Monday July 5th in observance of Independence Day.
- Parking passes are available at Town Hall. A \$50 resident permit includes Milliken and Memorial Park lots as well as Town Hall after hours.
