Focus will be on cleaning litter, trash, windblown construction debris along the **green** and **blue** trails and areas visible from the trails, see attached trail map. The secondary areas for clean-up of

construction litter will be Blueberry Plains and Goosefare Brook drainage conservation land owned by Town.

Older buried trash that has been exposed or visible in some areas along the trails will be identified for future reclamation project(s) on a case-by-case basis. The old trash on the surface of some locations can be picked up by volunteers for disposal.

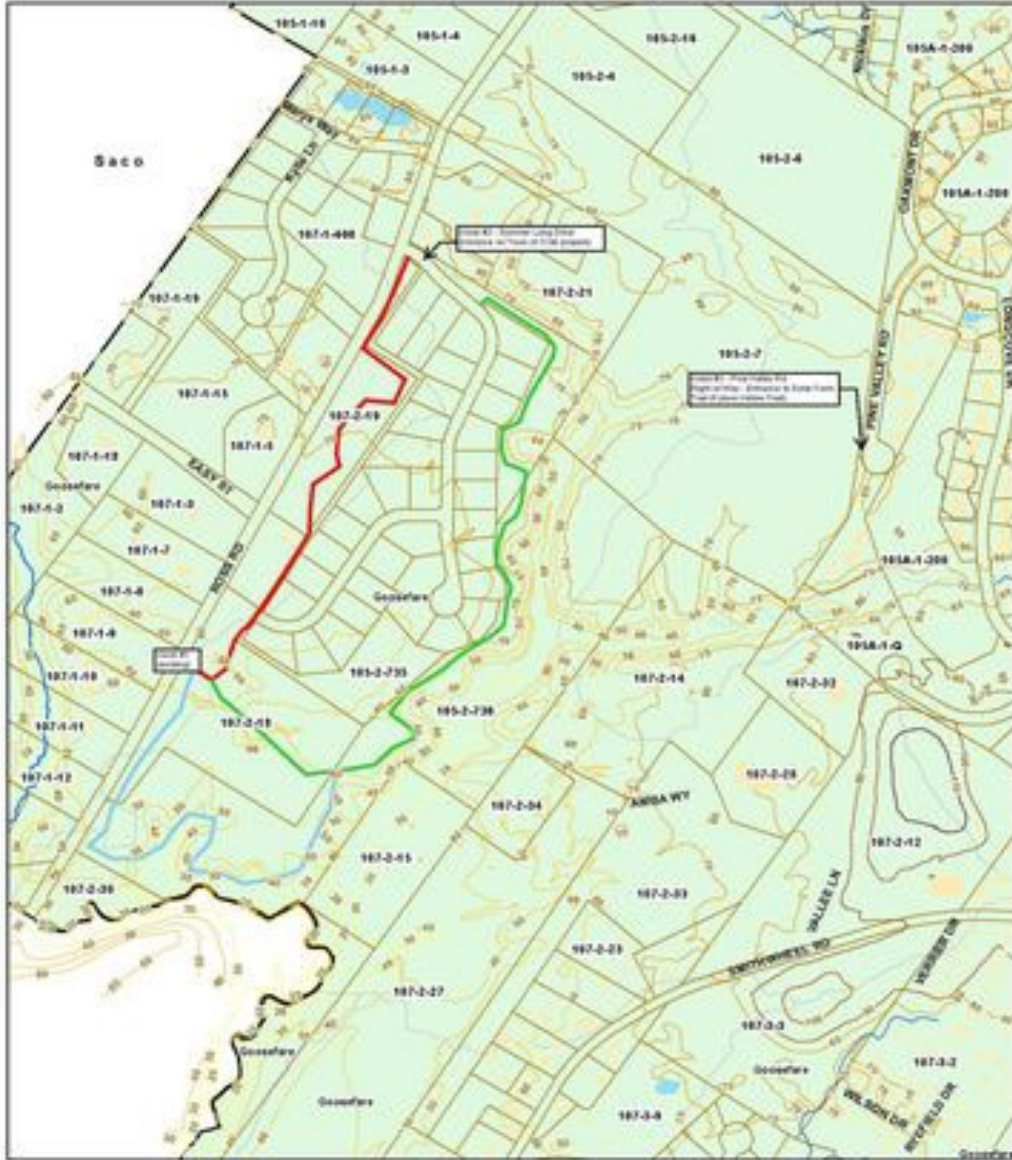
