According to your experience, wastewater license and knowledge in the wastewater field, the selected candidate will fill one of these positions: Operator, Senior Operator or Chief Operator, with the applicable respective pay range. The position will also include overtime, standby and on-call pay. Applicants must possess at least a grade 3 wastewater license: progressive work experience with a proven history in facility operations. Prior supervisory experience is desired. Applicants with grade 4 or 5 wastewater licenses may be eligible for a higher rate of pay.
