FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

MARCH 20, 2024

Today, March 20, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Maine triggering the release of Federal funds to help individuals and communities recover from Severe Storms and Flooding that occurred January 9-13, 2024. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Hazard Mitigation (HM):	(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of Maine are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the state and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
