The Town of Old Orchard Beach (ME) is looking to hire an individual to assist with maintaining the beauty and upkeep of the Veteran's Memorial Park. Listed below are some of the essential duties and responsibilities of these positions:

The duties listed below are intended only as illustrations of various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties do not exclude them from the position if work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

1. Overall care and maintenance of the park:
 - a. Watering
 - b. Weeding
 - c. Planting (shrubs, flowers, etc.)
 - d. Pruning
 - e. Mulching
 - f. Mowing
 - g. Morning pick up all ground debris.
 - h. Check Dog bag dispensers and add dog disposal bags as needed daily.
2. Landscaping (edging, stone dust, etc.)
3. Must know and understand the proper principles and techniques used in the maintenance of public parks and gardens.
4. Ability to use a wide variety of hand tools, like shovels, axes, weed eaters and post-hole diggers.
5. Must have valid driver's license to drive Gator within the park.
6. Assist with minor repairs within the park.
