Street Closures
& Pedestrian Access

for a Safe and
Happy 4th of July

In preparation for a safe fireworks display on July 4th, Old Orchard Beach will be implementing temporary road closures in the downtown area. These changes will allow for safe pedestrian movement and enhanced security throughout Old Orchard Street.

When **Friday, July 4th from
5 PM to approximately 12AM**

What to Expect:

- No vehicle traffic or parking will be allowed on Old Orchard Street during this time.
- Streets will reopen once public safety officials confirm that pedestrian traffic has safely dispersed.
- This closure ensures pedestrian-only access, supporting safety and access to downtown shops, restaurants, and attractions.

Road Closure Locations

Fixed barriers will be placed at the following intersections to block all vehicle access to Old Orchard Street.

Intersections at the corner of Old Orchard Street and:

- East Grand Ave ■ West Grand Ave
- Milliken Street ■ First Street
- Portland Avenue ■ Seavey Street
- Veterans Square

Businesses on Old Orchard Street

Businesses will remain open and accessible to foot traffic.

Parking Lots

All parking lots will be available and accessible.

Controlled Access Points

Motorists needing access to affected areas may do so by checking in at these designated access points:

- East Grand at Walnut Street
- West Grand at Atlantic Avenue
- First Street at Staples Street
- Milliken Street at Imperial Street

Please Note

Illegally parked vehicles within restricted areas will be ticketed or towed.
