Mark Koenigs & Kimbark

- OOB Town Manager wants to do a grant for town-developed projects; planning to ask Wright Pierce to cost out the scope of work. Three projects:
 - Trail to access ET in new Ahearn Woods property
 - Boat launch on Mill Pond
 - Kayak launch on Ross Road to access ponds on ocean side
- Note: Milliken Woods South is misnamed; the animal shelter property back to Kapok St is owned by OOB, not gifted by the Milliken family.
- Once awarded, two years to spend the money
- Grant won't be done this year (by September 25) so we'll push that app back a year
- Milliken Mills North side - Mark Tousignant requested that we install a sign acknowledging the Ahearn donation.
- Mark has taken readings for maps but they have to be turned into a layer on the GIS system to make maps of existing trails for Ahearn Woods. The Town GIS system map is incorrect.
- Mark and Kb have also walked and mapped Ocean Park trails.

3. Fall Fling - Charlie will help first session; Gina will help second session
4. Good and Welfare
 - a. Try to get our trails on AllTrails and TrailFinder.
 - b. Gina's interests - make sunblock and bug spray stations available on beach and trails. Supportive of composting and food systems. Loves biology and living things. Could evaluate trails for accessibility.
 - c. Charlie reported that piping plovers have increased in Maine, not on our beach but other places.
