Acceptable waste means all solid wastes of the type accepted at the transfer station used by the town, including all ordinary household, municipal, institutional, commercial and industrial wastes with the following exceptions: Demolition or construction debris from building and roadway projects or locations; Liquid wastes or sludges; Abandoned or junk vehicles; Hazardous waste, that is waste with inherent properties that make it dangerous to manage by ordinary means, including but not limited to chemicals, explosives, pathological wastes, radioactive wastes, toxic wastes and other wastes defined as hazardous by the state or the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended, or other federal, state or local laws, regulations, orders or other actions promulgated or taken with respect thereto; Dead animals or portions thereof or other pathological wastes; Water treatment residues; Tree stumps; Tannery sludge; Waste oil; and Discarded white goods, including but not limited to freezers, stoves, refrigerators and washing machines.

Unacceptable waste means all solid waste of the type municipalities are required to regulate by 38 M.R.S.A. § 1305, which specifically excludes industrial and sewage treatment plant sludge, and not included in the definition of acceptable waste.
